It is supposed to offer protection from the evil eye. It means the 'sprig of rue' and refers to the one of the most sacred Italian plants. The charm is made from silver and shaped as a rue sprig with 3 main branches. These symbolize the triple aspect of moon goddess (Diana Triformis) as a maiden, mother & crone. Several small charms hang on the tips of the branches, such as key that represents access to knowledge and power; fish that is symbolic of fertility and abundance; hand to fend off evil effect; flower for protection; and crescent moon representing the horns of God. It is I who was the first to enter the heart of youth and confront the lord of death.

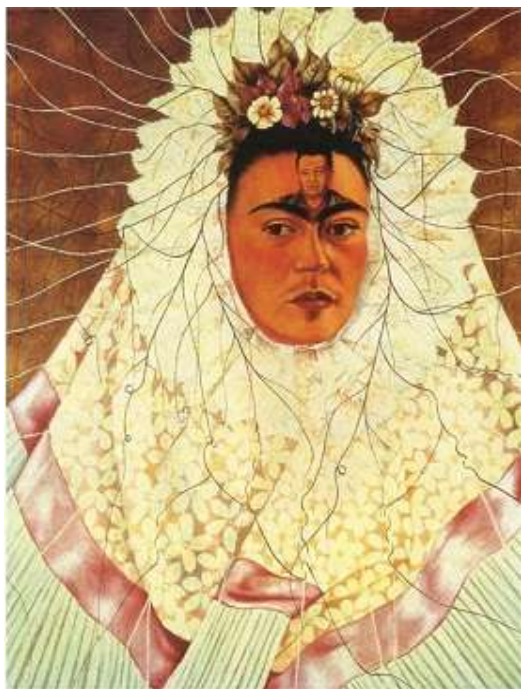
It is I who first took the vow to meet the divine in his own abode.

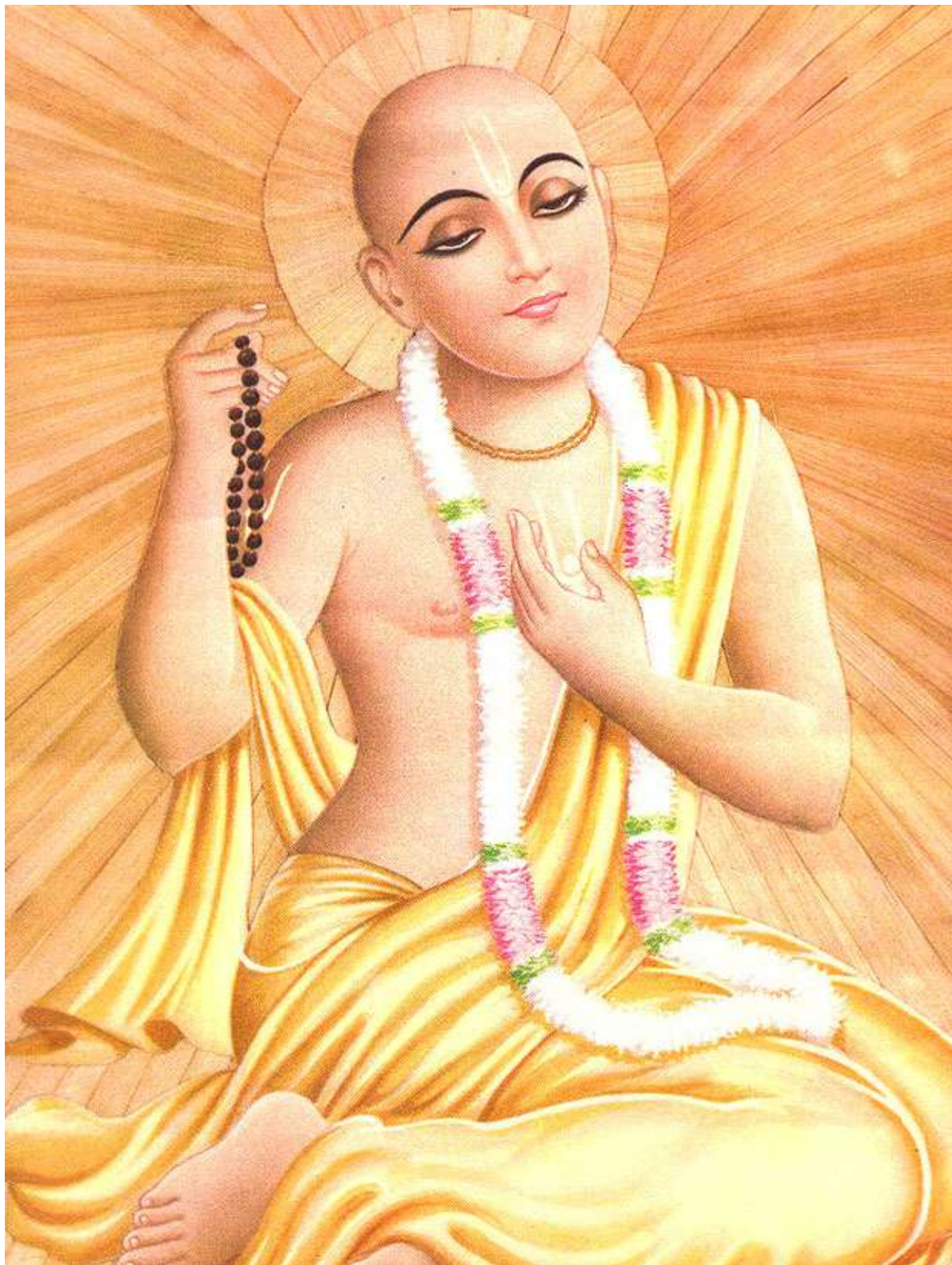
