Each point on the star has an emblem of a different biblical heroine (Adam, Ruth, Esther, Martha, and Electa)

and the qualities they represent-fidelity, constancy, loyalty, faith, and love. The initials "F.A.T.A.L." found on some are said to stand for the phrase, "Fairest Among Thousands, Altogether Lovely," a reference from the Song of Songs, although also an apt description, perhaps, of some of the biblical heroines above.
